#### **Summary of Presentation:**

- My Blueprint is an online tool for course selection and used in Careers/Civics, but also useful for education, career and pathway planning.
- Must use the specific site <u>www.myblueprint.ca/simcoe</u>
- If you just Google it, you are not in the right spot
- Click Sign up, choose Nottawasaga Pines Secondary School, select Family/Advisor and choose grade range 7-12, then fill out personal information (verified email and create password)
- Link to a student once logged in, all students are linked to a SCDSB account, so just enter the student's email. Students then receive a request to approve the link.
- Once student approves the link, you can access everything.
- Click Get started!
- Can view messages or click on Student Feed to see Student activity in the program
- Show's progress on expected tasks for each grade in terms of pathway and career planning (displays as a % of completion)
- Click Student view at the top to see what student account and tasks look like. Left hand menu includes these features:
- WHO AM I TAB > Under the Learning styles surveys, personality surveys, interest surveys
- HIGH SCHOOL TAB >Can create multiple plans for course pathways, to show parents and students what prerequisites are required and what courses are available at their specific school
- POST SECONDARY TAB > Search by program (eg. welding) and it will show all available colleges/universities/apprenticeships, tells program length, if you are

eligible based on your course completion, and the tuition amount for each program, as well as related programs or occupations

- WORK TAB > shows education requirements, description, job prospects, videos to show what daily tasks are completed by someone in that occupation, also has a resume and cover letter template (fill in the blank style) that can be exported and used, and also has live job searches
- MONEY TAB > Can create budgets (income vs. expense), tips for how much to put away for post secondary school, etc
- FAVOURITES TAB > Students and parents can save and favourite occupations and post secondary programs.

\* The more info you give the program the more specific the suggestions are that it gives. \*Students can win prizes for completing tasks.
